<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Pair with <a href="#">Well Child Visit</a> and submit on electronic claim 837P</li> <li>◆ Document formal <a href="#">Caries Risk Assessment</a> in patient chart</li> <li>◆ Reimbursable twice per year, two additional per year for high caries risk children</li> </ul>	

#### Billing Ages 5-20

<b>D0190</b> Dental Screening	<b>\$17.02</b>
<b>D1206</b> Topical Fluoride Varnish	<b>\$17.13</b>
<b>Z13.84</b> Screening for dental disorders (EPSDT ICD 10—Diagnosis codes)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Reimbursable a maximum three times, regardless of risk</li> <li>◆ Not required to pair with well child; submit on electronic claim 837P</li> </ul>	

#### Caries Risk Assessment

- ◆ Documentation of risk using a [Pediatric Oral Health Screening form](#) must be part of the child member's medical and/or dental record.

#### Ages 12–20 years

Course 3 (adult oral health) and Course 6 (fluoride varnish).
- ◆ Qualified Medical Personnel include Physicians (MDs), Osteopaths (DOs), Nurse Practitioners (NPs) and Physicians Assistants (PAs) with a focus on primary care, general practice, internal medicine or pediatrics and who have completed training.
  - ◆ Qualified Medical Personnel who complete this training must provide **documentation of this training** when requested.
